Childcare Provider

Job Description

The Berean Childcare Provider is a part-time, seasonal employee of Berean Baptist Church, hired to provide childcare during any or all of the following programs: Tuesday morning Mom to Mom (meeting 2 – 3 times per month during the school year), Wednesday morning Women's Bible Studies (weekly throughout the school year), Special Events such as when childcare is offered for a special training or all-church event. This position reports directly to the Childcare Supervisor and will receive additional instruction for the Room Supervisor.

Responsibilities

- Observe and monitor children's play activities.
- Guide children in health and personal habits such as eating, resting, and toilet habits.
- Read and play with children.
- Organize and participate in recreational activities, such as games, songs and crafts.
- Assist in preparing snacks for children – serve meals or refreshments to children as necessary.
- Organize and store toys and materials to ensure order in activity areas.
- Clean toys that have been played with.
- Maintain a safe and secure environment.
- Ensure that check-in and pick-up procedures are followed.
- Change diapers (female providers only)
- Report any concerns regarding a child's well-being immediately to Pastor Ben Holden or a Berean Kids staff member.

- Agree with the Berean Baptist Statement of Faith
- Passion for children and families to see their lives, communities and world transformed by the power of the gospel
- Education and/or experience with children and children's education
- Proven ability for problem solving and making rational, in-the-moment decisions
- Strong relational and communication skills
- Ability to work on a team
- Adeptness to work effectively with a variety of personalities, skill levels and situations
- Trained on Berean Kids policies and procedures
