Matthew 19:4-6

#### Read Matthew 19:4-6 together:

He answered, "Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."

## A Jesus Revolution in Marriage

#### **Submitting Replaces Controlling**

Read Ephesians 5:21-28.

#### **Humility Replaces Selfishness**

Read Philippians 2:3-4.

- ? Is it possible to self-diagnose selfishness? Why or why not?
- ? How can the exercise of humility bring about healthy submission?
- ? What are the five love languages? Why is it important to understand your spouse's love language?

### **Blessing Replaces Contempt**

Read 1 Peter 3:8-9.

- ? What does contempt look like in a marriage? How is it so destructive in a Christian marriage?
